Additional features

Vacuum unit and suction skirt: The combination of vacuum unit and suction skirt is an ideal solution to prevent dust emission into the air. During spray cleaning, the skirt also acts as a splash protector.

Direct solution distribution: The cleaning solution is distributed through the centre of the pad, using the whole surface of the pad. An electrical spray unit is fitted as standard.

Full pad contact: The floating pad drive gives a constant working pressure and enables the machine to be used on uneven floors.

Robustness: TASKI ergodisc 400 machines are part of an innovative range of single disc machines. The use of high-tech materials creates robust, shock absorbing machines with an extended lifetime and low service costs.
